Locations: France or Singapore, with a mandatory campus exchange between the two campuses

About the mid-August 2025 PhD recruitment:

The INSEAD PhD will soon begin recruiting candidates in the eight areas of specialisation to start their studies in Singapore or France for the next five years (with a mandatory campus exchange between the two locations in the first year). Each area provides an exciting and rigorous environment for students to receive intensive research training and conduct high-quality research. Prospects apply for the INSEAD PhD to pursue an exciting career in business academia as a management professor.

- Conduct original and high-quality research in their chosen area.

- A minimum undergraduate degree, even outside of business, as long as there is an interest in applying knowledge to the chosen field of specialisation. A master's degree is preferable but not essential.

- Good written and verbal communication skills
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively in a research-oriented environment
- Demonstrate interest in pursuing an academic career in their chosen area

Interested applicants must submit an online application when it opens in September. In the meantime, prospects are encouraged to prepare their portfolio, which includes the following:

- Curriculum vitae (CV), including educational and professional background.
- Statement of Purpose outlining research interests, goals, and reasons for applying to INSEAD, possibly detailing future collaborations with INSEAD faculty. We do not require applicants to select an advisor and submit a formal research proposal in the application packet. Applicants finalise their advisor and submit the proposal only in year 3 of the programme.
- Academic transcripts from relevant institutions.
- Three letters of recommendation, preferably with at least one letter from an academic referee; industry recommendations are also accepted.
- A valid GMAT or GRE score (less than five years old; classic or new editions accepted).
- The TOEFL test is required from applicants whose native language is not English; however, we will waive the TOEFL if one of your degrees is taught exclusively in English.
- 50 € application fee per application submitted

Regardless of nationality and background, all admitted students receive funding for the first five years* of the programme. We renew this generous benefit annually based on the applicant's satisfactory progress.

**The total research and conference budget includes an exceptional one-time top-up of 5,000 € and S\$ 10,000 for Europe and Asia campuses, respectively. PhD Students receive this top-up upon completing Year 3 (going to Year 4). PhD candidates are eligible for R&D funding for critical research projects like dissertations, publications, etc., subject to approval by the relevant parties allocating the funds. The five-year overall funding ends at the end of June of Year 5 or as soon as a candidate begins working while still completing their graduation requirements (if this occurs before the end of June in Year 5).*
