SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS*

Regardless of nationality and background, all admitted students receive funding for the *first five years of studies**. This benefit is available to all admitted PhD students, renewable annually based on satisfactory progress in the programme.

[#]The total research and conference budget support includes an exceptional one-time top-up of € 5,000 and S\$ 10,080 for Europe and Asia campuses, respectively. PhD candidates receive this top-up upon completing Year 3 (going to Year 4). Furthermore, upon request, PhD candidates are eligible for R&D funding for critical research projects like dissertations, publications, etc., subject to approval by relevant parties allocating the funds and the PhD Programme Office.

WHAT ARE THE NEXT STEPS?

- Prepare for the GMAT or GRE early to take the test; online application opens in early September for the following year's intake.
- Gain valuable research experience in any field through your degree requirements or professional experience. Some examples of research experience include graduate dissertations, research projects as part of your curriculum requirements, industry internships in a consulting firm, RA work in school or a laboratory, etc.
- Reflect on your research interests; read about faculty's research interests through their profiles. Although not required to seek a supervisor when applying, we encourage prospects to review any possible collaborations with our faculty should they get hired in the PhD Programme.

*The funding will end at the end of June in year 5 (by which time a candidate is expected to have secured an academic position) or as soon as a candidate begins working at a university, business school, or any other relevant institution while still completing their graduation requirements (if this occurs before the end of June in year 5). Annual support, i.e., tuition fee, stipend, research and conference budget, and health insurance coverage, regularly undergoes review. Newly admitted and current students must consult the PhD Programme Office for the latest updates.
